By a unanimous vote of the Huntersville Town Board, funds were made available for the design and installation of a TEMPORARY traffic light at Northdowns Land and Rt 21. As a reminder, the light is to be there until the planned road widening project requires it to be removed. The very positive discussion by Board members included comments by Mayor Pro Tem Stacy Phillips, apologizing for the length of time it took for this type of action to be taken.
