## General News and Updates

### Huntersville Town Board Agrees to Study Northdowns Lane/Statesville Road Traffic Light

During the Huntersville Town Board meeting on Monday, June 6, following our March request for approval and funding of a traffic light at Statesville Road, the commissioners agreed to study the costs/funding and timeframe required. At this meeting we were represented by Alex Lacy, Practice Administrator for OrthoCarolina, Leslie Welch, Hamptons HOA VP, and Hamptons resident Bob Inskeep. Following remarks by Alex and Bob and a presentation by Town Engineering Director Stephen Trott, the Board engaged in a discussion which led to the decision to initiate the study. The next meeting in which staff will be discussing the light study is scheduled for **Tuesday, June 21 at Town Hall @ 6:00 pm**. The Board meetings are open to the public so please consider coming to show support and hear the discussion. You are free to leave the meeting following the light discussion. Whether or not a stop light is ultimately approved is still yet to be determined, but it is a positive sign that the Board and staff are proceeding with this study.

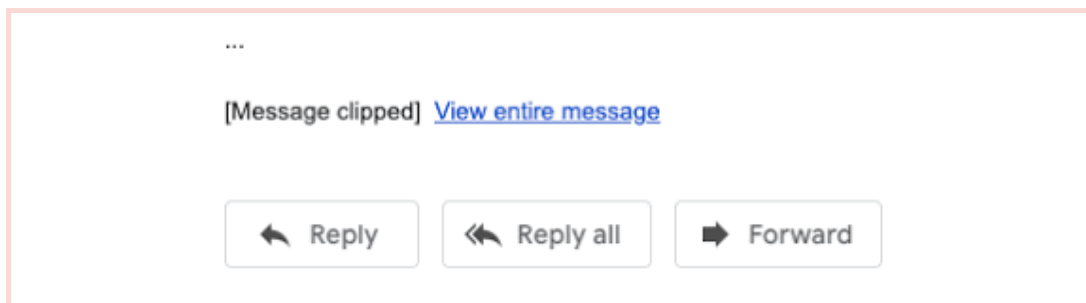
### Lost and Found bins are Filling Up

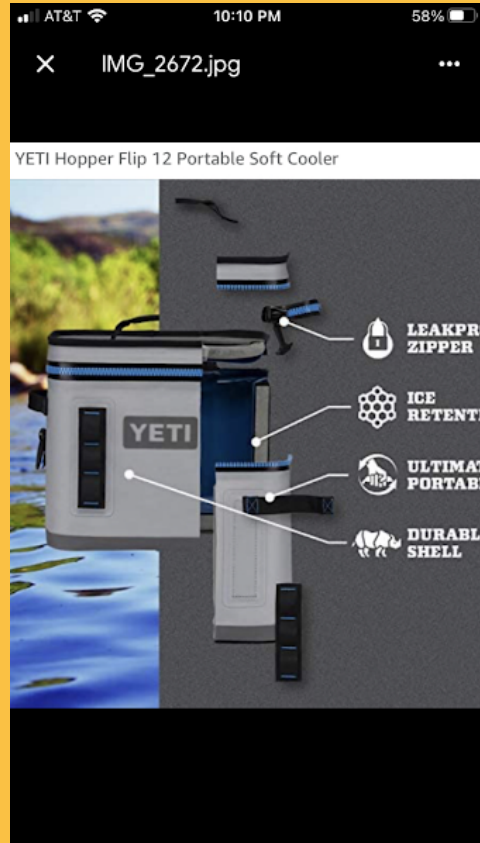

### Sign up for Swim Lessons at Doyers

July 11-28, Mon-Thur 10-11:00am

#### For Hamptons residents:

Member must be in good standing to sign their child for private swim lessons. They will need to create a Jumbula account to access the sessions [via this link](#). Once they click on the session they would like, they add all participants (child and sibling if applicable) to their account, include the required child's information, read and accept the Swim Lesson Waiver, and pay for the session. Members must read and pay attention to the Swim Lesson Waiver for all guidelines pertaining to the swim lessons, including cancelling of a class.

A session is made up of four (4) 30-minute classes. Each session cost's \$185. If one sibling is around the same age and at the same swim level, they may be added to the same session at an additional cost of \$65. Any child must be 3 years old prior to the start of the swim lesson class. We teach beginners/basic levels for young children. Some examples are as follows:

**Tadpole 1:** entering & exiting water safely, blowing bubbles in water, submerging and floating, rollover in water, exploring arm and hand movements, water safety, independence in water, how to get help

**Tadpole 2:** Jumping/exiting safely, multiple seconds of floatation, gliding, and rollover in water. Treading water, water safety, how to get help

**Minnow:** More advanced entering/exiting safely, submerging/retrieving objects, gliding, floating, freestyle swim, backstroke swim, treading water, water safety, how to get help

### Important Pool Rules

***The following paragraph pertains to young swimmers planning on swimming in both the Vixen and/or Doyers pools:***

Parents must take their children aged 10-13 yrs old to Doyers for a swim test if the children will be going to either of our pools throughout the summer ***unaccompanied by an adult***. Swimmers in this age range that pass the test will receive the status of "provisional swimmer", which enables them to be at the pools unaccompanied by an adult. The child will receive a key tag that they **MUST** bring to the pool each time. The "provisional swimmer" key tag will be specific to that child and they may not bring guests or other children under the age of 10. Children who have not demonstrated adequate swim skills to the on-duty lifeguard will be asked to leave if unaccompanied by an adult.
