### A Few Reminders Regarding our Tennis Courts



For those of you interested in using our online court reservation system for Tennis/Pickleball, please refresh yourselves with the following rules/regulations:

- Court usage is first come first serve basis unless otherwise reserved on the court sign up calendar.
- Courts are for residents and their guests. At least 50% of the participants should be Hamptons residents.
- Courts can not be used for personal business purposes (Ie-lessons, clinics) unless the recipients of the service are Hamptons residents.
- A maximum of 2 courts for 2 hours can be reserved at one time per resident. Courts should not be blocked out as space holders. Only book a reservation for the courts which will be used.
- Should a reservation no longer be needed, the reservation should be removed from the system to allow others to book those courts.
- Reservations will be held for 10 minutes past start time. If ten minutes pass and court is empty, it becomes
  available to the next player.
- Court reservations can only be made up to 2 weeks in advance unless otherwise approved by HOA board/tennis chair. Any other reservations will be deleted by the tennis chair
- HOA sponsored events take priority for court usage.
- Players are responsible for placing all trash in the trash receptacles nothing should be left behind in the courts

Also, please refrain from having dogs/pets on the courts. If for some reason you have a dog on the court, please pick up after them.

For convenience, there is a leaf blower on the porch patio at Doyers. The code for the lock is 15800. Unfortunately we don't have one at Vixen because there currently is nowhere to put it for easy access.

HOA Dues Payment Information Changing
\*\* Important Update - Action Required \*\*

Residents should have received the following information via email and regular mail from Cedar Management:

"Beginning November 1, 2022 the bank accounts for Hamptons at Northcross Homeowners Association will be transitioned to Alliance Association Bank (AAB) for all association banking services. Although this change is not officially effective until 11/1/22 you may begin using these new payment options right away.

AAB specializes in community association banking and provides products and services uniquely designed for community associations like Hamptons at Northcross Homeowners Association. With recent changes in the banking industry and advances in technology, Cedar Management Group (CMG) is excited to partner with AAB to take advantage of their specialized services in community association banking.

#### Payment Options Available - Action required

CMG in conjunction with AAB offers multiple payment options. We have provided the detailed information for those options below. It is important that you note that not updating the payment information for your association dues payment will result in delayed processing, possible return checks and potential late fees. To avoid these concerns, we ask that you review the below options carefully and select the one that is best suited for you at this time.

#### **Pay Online**

For online payment options please visit our website at www.mycmg.com/pay.

Online payment options include the below:

- ACH Recurring Payment This option allows for a recurring direct debit withdrawal from your account.
   You are allowed to choose the frequency and the date of the withdrawal. AAB offers a reminder email 10 days prior to the debit of your account. This option is free.
- eCheck This option allows you to make payment using your bank account. The fee is \$1.95 per transaction.
- Credit or Debit Card All major credit or debit cards are accepted. A service fee applies and is charged at the time of payment. The Credit Card service fee is 3%. The Debit Card flat fee is \$5.00 per transaction.

### **Update: 241 Unit Apartment Complex on Sam Furr Road**

In an effort to lessen the impact on our home values, our peace of mind, and our crowded roads, a group of concerned neighbors have formed a subcommittee to oppose the 241-unit apartment complex being planned adjacent to our neighborhood. The following highlights outline the effects of this project:

- · Lowered home values
- · Increased traffic during peak hours
- Using the Hamptons as a "cut-through"
- · Encroachment of our amenities by non-residents
- Potential for increased crime
- Many of our neighbors will have their privacy stripped away from them.


