November-Reusable Shopping Bags - Waste Reduction Tip #5

Did you know that Americans use approximately 300 billion plastic bags annually and only about 3% of those get recycled. While many people re-use them for other purposes (picking up dog poop is a popular use) many bags get thrown directly into the trash. While plastic bags can be recycled, consider bringing your own re-useable bags which has considerably less impact on our world. By bringing your own bag you reduce your oil consumption (plastic bags are made from oil) and you reduce the risk of your bag getting from our trash to our oceans.

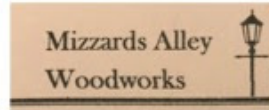
