Sure we have the ability to recycle but a lot of what we put in our trash could be re-used or repurposed in some other way. See below for a tip! April - Terracycle Recycling - a place to recycle hard to recycle items - Waste Reduction Tip #10

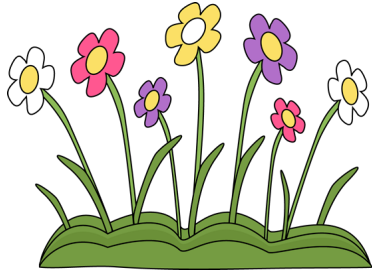
We as a society buy a lot and consume a lot. With that comes the price of waste. How much can you recycle at your curb? Not enough, but there are other opportunities to recycle. In February the focus was on TREX plastic film recycling. This month it is a company called [Terracycle](#). Some of their programs are free and some need to be paid for. They recycle anything from cigarette butts to pens to chip bags. I personally recycle for free solo cups, rubbermaid containers, writing instruments (this is for the school where I work) and personal care products. I pay for plastic recycling that is not recyclable at the curb. For the free programs I send in 1-2 shipments a year. For the plastic recycling I send in a shipment about 4 times per year.

You may be thinking that mailing recycling is silly or isn't there a carbon footprint to mailing it? In my opinion there is a carbon footprint, but there is a much larger larger carbon footprint when we don't. When we recycle we divert waste from our landfills and conserve energy by using less raw materials and less fossil fuels. When we conserve energy that energy can be used for something else!

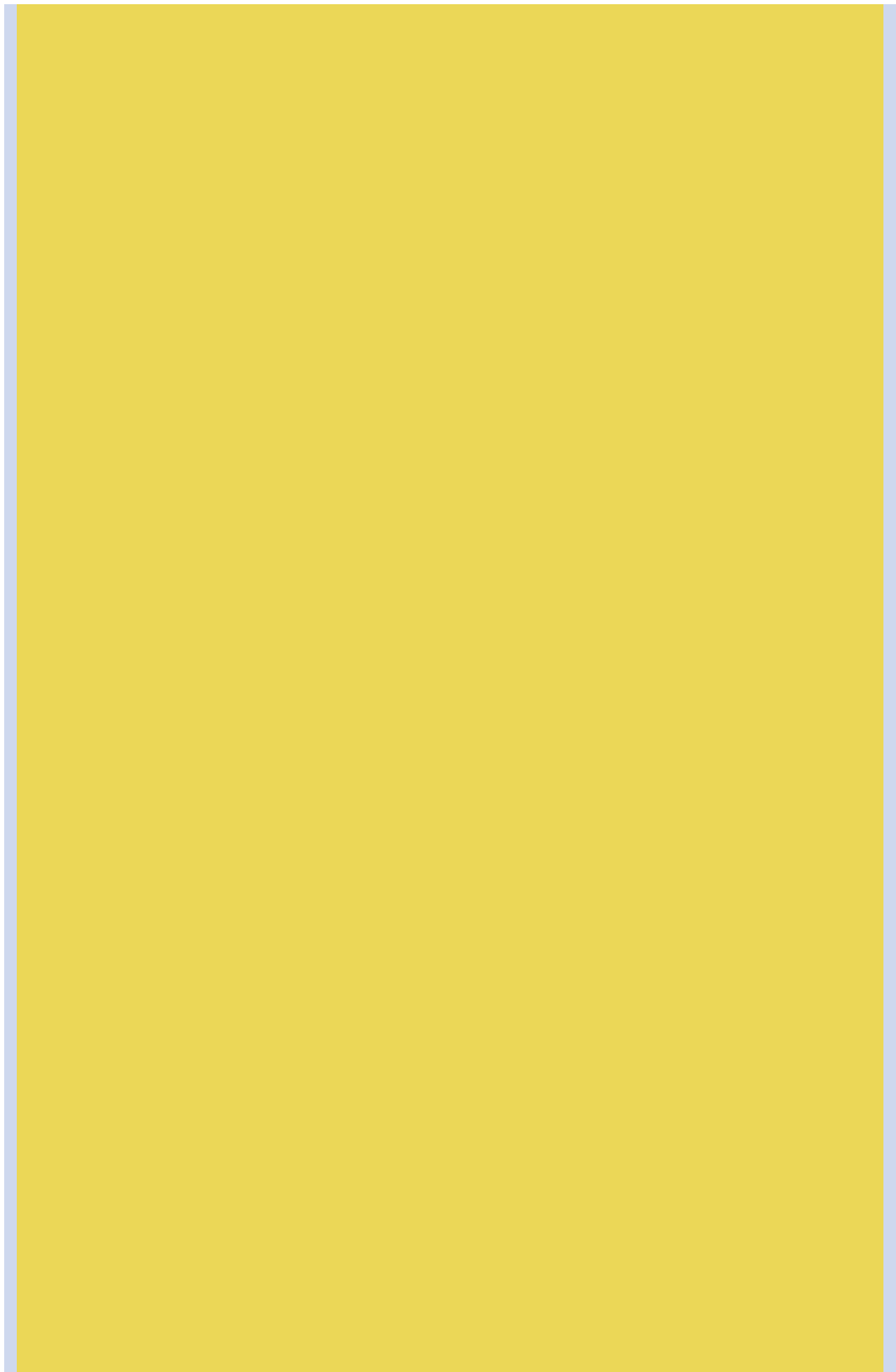

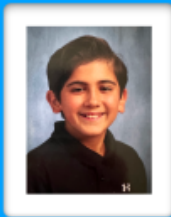
