**Important Pool Rules**

*The following paragraph pertains to young swimmers planning on swimming in both the Vixen and/or Doyers pools:*

Parents must take their children aged 10-13 yrs old to Doyers for a swim test if the children will be going to either of our pools throughout the summer **unaccompanied by an adult**. Swimmers in this age range that pass the test will receive the status of "provisional swimmer", which enables them to be at the pools unaccompanied by an adult. The child will receive a key tag that they **MUST** bring to the pool each time. The "provisional swimmer" key tag will be specific to that child and they may not bring guests or other children under the age of 10. Children who have not demonstrated adequate swim skills to the on-duty lifeguard will be asked to leave if unaccompanied by an adult.

**Recycling News You Can Use**

Ever think about the garbage bin we put out every Sunday night and wonder if there are any ways to reduce what you throw away? Sure we have the ability to recycle but a lot of what we put in our trash could be re-used or re-purposed in some other way. See below for a tip! **July - Single Use Plastics - Waste Reduction Tip #13**

Single use plastics: You may have heard this term before. If not, it is just what it sounds like - something made of plastic, designed to be thrown away, often a few minutes after it has been used. Examples include plastic grocery bags, straws, plastic silver ware, and take away coffee cups. While it may not seem like much if you use a plastic straw, for a few minutes, and then throw it away, consider some of these facts:

Some facts (Source: **Center for Biological Diversity**)

- Americans use 100 billion plastic bags a year
- In 2015 about 730,000 tons of plastic bags, sacks and wraps were generated in the United States, but more than 87% of those items are never recycled, winding up in landfills and the ocean.
- About 34% of dead leatherback sea turtle have ingested plastics.
- It takes 1,000 years for a plastic bag to degrade in a landfill. Unfortunately, the bags don't break down completely but instead photo-degrade, becoming microplastics that absorb toxins and continue to pollute the environment.
- It is estimated that we use 500 million plastic straws daily around the world (Source: **USA Today**). Note: This is a generalized statistic based on how many straws companies produce



We need plastic in our lives: gloves used for surgery, plastic in our automobiles, TV's, appliances, etc., but shouldn't we consider stopping our use of single use plastics when there are often alternatives?

Single Use Plastic Non-Plastic Alternative

- Plastic grocery bags Bring your own reusable bags
- Plastic Silverware Bring your own metal silverware
- Plastic Straws Bring your own reusable straw
- Take away coffee cups Bring your own coffee mug
